

Clerk to the Governing Body

Permanent

An average of 3 hours per week; term time only

Salary Grade 6 (£12.64 per hour)

We are looking for a clerk to provide support and advice to our governing body (GB) to help them fulfil their strategic role of ensuring Mayfield provides the best possible education for our pupils.

The clerk's role involves organising meetings, preparing agendas, providing advice on procedural matters, taking accurate minutes at meetings and ensuring that we have everything in place to be able to carry out our statutory duties effectively. The ability to use your own initiative and to work independently is essential as are good interpersonal, ICT and organisational skills.

Most of the work can be undertaken on a flexible basis at home. However, you will be expected to attend governing body meetings which are generally held at the school in the evening - a schedule of this year's meetings is available on our website. Each meeting lasts a maximum of two hours.

The salary is based on working an average of three hours per week during term time; the actual hours will vary from week to week.

Some knowledge of how schools and governing bodies operate would be an advantage but full training and support will be provided to candidates who demonstrate the necessary skills. There is an expectation that regular training and development will be undertaken to maintain knowledge and develop practice.
