# Drop in session for advice with the SENCo

We are finding increasingly that now that we have no early intervention family support workers there is a gap for parents to access advice when they have concerns about their children such as low self–esteem, worries, toileting, sleep, emotional wellbeing, anxiety, behaviour etc.

However, sometimes parents would like to discuss concerns with school staff initially and have some direction of what to do/where to go. We are offering drop in sessions for parents to meet with the schools SENCo where children are not on the schools SEN register. The SENCo normally deals with higher level cases, but we are finding with the cuts within county more queries are coming into schools so we are offering these sessions to try and offer advice and /or direct parents to other agencies that may be able to assist them.
