New Parking Restrictions near to Mayfield

The Benson North scheme goes live on this coming Monday, 23rd November. It means that from 9am to noon, Monday to Friday cars can only park in the bays/non-double yellow line areas with a residents permit or buy a ticket. Normal double yellow line rules apply where appropriate, of course. The traffic wardens have been out over the last couple of days issuing warnings in the area to cars that have parked with no permits so it seems that they will be enforcing this rigorously.
