Curriculum: Our curriculum was written collaboratively by the teaching staff. Over the last five years it has been developed to ensure that teachers have a clear understanding of expectations against objectives, and the progression of skills and knowledge. Objectives across the subjects are delivered through topics, and whilst there is a firm structure for this teachers have the flexibility to change the topic theme and programme of delivery across the year as appropriate to the children they are teaching. Summative and formative assessments are recorded on our online platform, OTrack, which provides planning direction for teachers and the ability to track data across the school instantly.
