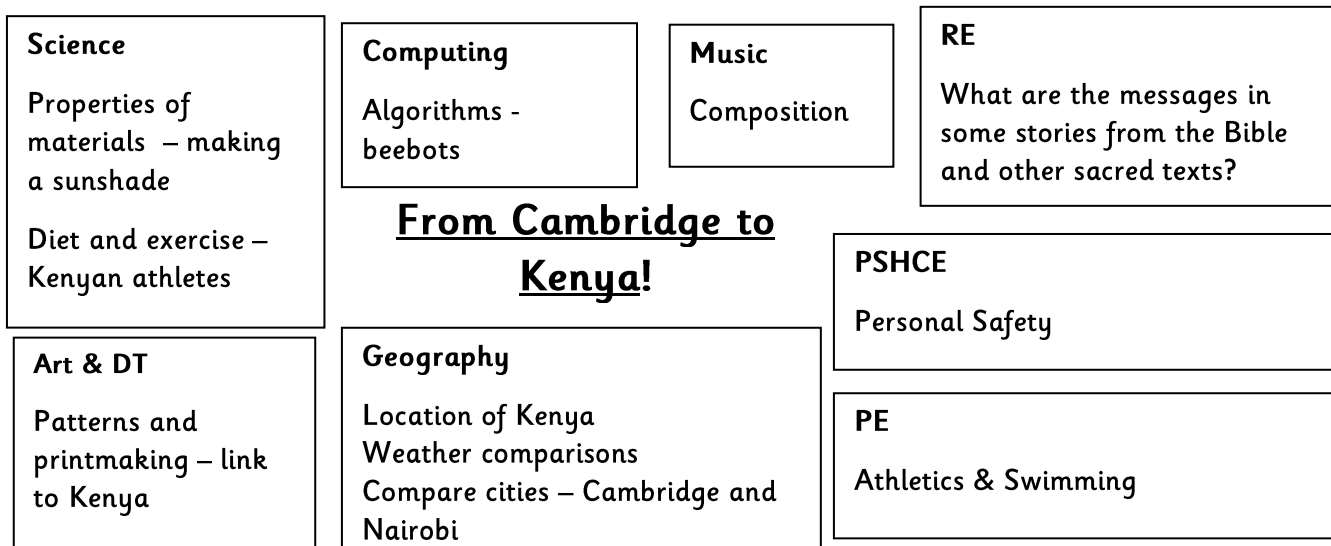


Dear Parents,

Summer 2 is the final half term of the academic year! We want to end Year 2 on a high and we are introducing a brand new topic: From Cambridge to Kenya.

| Maths    | We will continue increasing the children's confidence with the 2, 5 and 10 times table in fluency and look at division facts.<br>We will be revising addition (with regrouping), subtraction (including the term 'finding the difference') in connection with learning about capacity, weight and volume.<br>We will also be learning to tell the time and solve maths problems linked to time.   |
| English  | In English, we continue to work on developing the children's reading comprehension skills (vocabulary, prediction, inference, explanation and sequencing); to improve their independent writing skills, (to confidently write sentences which make sense, and re-read them, correct and improve them); to read for enjoyment and to write to entertain and inform. We will teach these skills through poetry, responding to texts, 'Bringing the rain to Kapiti Plain,' 'Lila and the secret of rain' and a short animation called 'Zahra'. |
