Mayfield Primary School is a large and successful primary school on the north side of Cambridge City. We have encouraging results, a strong international feel and a reputation for being welcoming to all. Our intake is very diverse which is something we celebrate; through meeting the needs of each individual learner, we help them achieve their personal best. We enthusiastically promote learning out of doors and use 'Spirals of Inquiry' as part of our approach (A framework for transforming learning in schools: Innovation and the spiral of inquiry: Helen Timperley, Linda Kaser and Judy Halbert, Centre for Strategic Education, 2014).

There are currently 390 pupils on roll and 14 classes. Currently we have 23 children with EHCPs, 7 of whom are deaf, as well as a significant proportion of children with high level needs.

We seek to provide a lively, stimulating and sensitive environment for our children, with an emphasis on the quality of relationships. We have very keen, enthusiastic parents and governors who are eager to help and are interested in all aspects of school life.

Mayfield has a team approach to school development and improvement, with all teachers involved in each of the aims of our School Development Plan. We use the 'Spiral of Inquiry' approach, as outlined above, as we work together on the SDP. We recognise the value of educational research and are a school that encourages engagement with it. Teachers undertake research projects, further study and training through a range of routes. Last year the school gained the 'CollectivEd Gold Award for coaching, mentoring and professional development'. Our OFSTED inspection in 2017 graded us as good.

Mayfield is committed to the protection and safety of all our pupils. The successful candidate will be required to undertake a DBS check.
