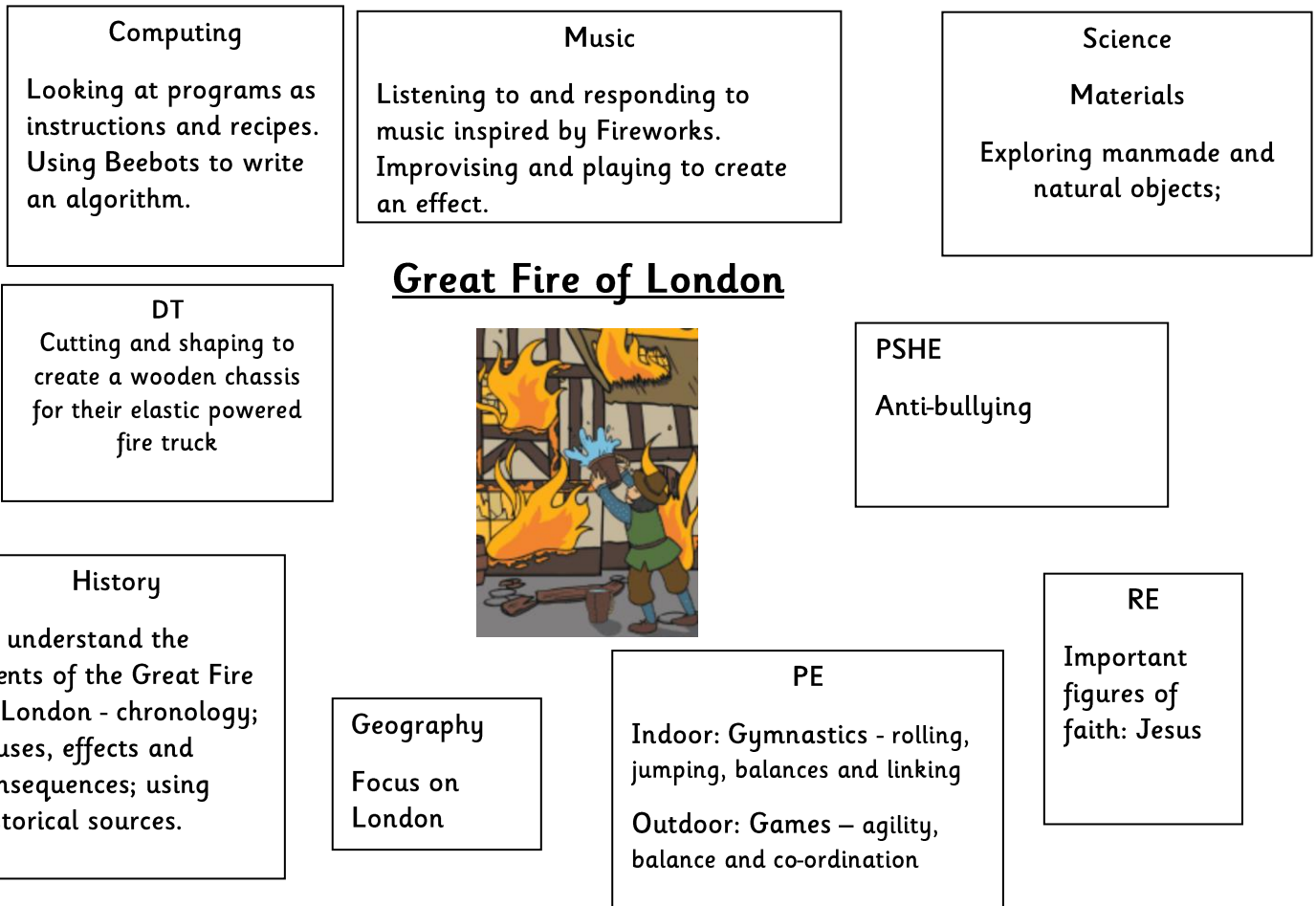


Dear Parents,

In Spring 1 our topic will be *The Great Fire of London* – the topic web below roughly outlines how the different subjects will be covered.



English	<p>We are looking at stories linked to the topic: <i>Vlad and the Great Fire of London</i>; <i>Toby and the Great Fire of London</i> as well as non-fiction texts - 'The Great Fire of London' by Emma Adams.</p> <p>We will continue our work on capital letters, full stops; using conjunctions - 'or', 'but', 'when', 'if', 'that', 'because'; asking questions using question marks; writing instructions and non-fiction reports.</p> <p>Guided Reading will link to our topic as much as possible and centre around the skills of VIPERS (Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Sequencing).</p>
Maths	Multiplication and division and 3Dshape. We will continue to work on number bonds and times tables and division facts (2, 5 and 10)
