This continues to be another packed week of activities at Mayfield. All of the KS2 classes have been out of school this week on various trips, including the Year 5 trip to Kentwell. Next week is just as busy! On **Tuesday afternoon**, the children will be meeting their new teacher. In a change from previous years, they need to be collected at the end of the day from their **CURRENT** classroom.
