Cashless School

For some years we have offered an e-payment method using a very secure website called ParentPay and we are now making a strong effort to become a cashless school in order to improve security and reduce administration time in school.

Making a payment using ParentPay is straightforward and **no card details are stored** in any part of the system. Once you've activated your account you can make online payments straight away. You can access ParentPay at any time of the day (or night) from any computer or device with internet access. You can use ParentPay to give consent and pay for trips, to view your dinner money balance and to see a full record of payments made. It's really easy to use and very convenient. If you are not able to pay online you can pay in cash at local stores where you see the PayPoint logo – please ask us for details of how to do this.
