

## Sport Premium Expenditure April 2020-April 2021

Sport Premium Funding is allocated and 'ring-fenced' to be spent on PE and sport in schools.

For the 2020-2021 financial year, Mayfield Primary School received £19,500 plus the carry forward of £12,333 from the previous year making a total of £31,833.

Our expenditure over the last financial year is as follows:

Coaches for out of school extra-curricular sports activities	£1008.97	Provides children with extracurricular opportunities in sport such as rugby, netball, football, running and triathlon.
Equipment for use in PE lessons	£2772.84	Equipment ordered as a result of a 'resource audit' to ensure there is sufficient equipment to teach each sport in PE lessons as well as each class having own sets of basic equipment for use at own leisure or in lessons.
Storage boxes and bags for PE equipment	£284.10	To ensure equipment is organised and stored appropriately.
Compete PE Planning Resource	£1947.50	Supports teachers' planning of the PE curriculum. This planning is aimed more towards teaching 'sports' rather than fundamental skills and gives children a taster of different sports as well

		as learning new skills, rules and taking part in healthy competition.
Competitions and events	£240	Entry to county-wide Sport for All event and merchandise.
School Sports Partnership	£1130	Provides a support network and key information about competitions and the School Games Mark.
Specialist School Support	£2800	Support from Chesterton Community College.
CPD regarding safe practice in PE for schools relating to Covid-19	£44.99	A book to support teaching of PE safely during the pandemic.

We are expecting to receive the balance of the 20/21 academic year funding of **£8,141** during the summer term.

The impact of the funding will be measured through:

- Considering any new activity – question before we start and at end to consider impact
- Feedback from teachers on CPD and on inter-school activities
- Survey of children accessing out of school sports activities
- Survey of children regarding interest in / participation in inter house / class sports
