	If you would like your child to have it and have not completed a consent form, please do so and return it to the office by 12.00 Thursday. Paper copies are available from the office or are attached to the ParentMail sent out yesterday. A completed consent form is required in order to give your child the immunisation.

The actual money will not be taken from your lunch money balance until the day of the meal. <u>Bookings will not be taken after 4th December.</u>

If your KS2 child is entitled to Free School Meals we will assume they are having a Christmas lunch – please let Shapla know if this is not the case.
