The Arthur Rank is an incredible organisation. Founded in 1981, Arthur Rank Hospice supports people living in Cambridge with an advanced serious illness or a life-limiting condition and those in need of end-of-life care.

Every child will be given a set of antlers to keep, and are invited to come to school dressed in red/brown (like a reindeer!). We have a special guest attending to complete the warm up with the children before they run.

Car Park Safety	If your child comes in early for sports clubs please have a chat with them about safety in the car park. Children need to use the paths rather than walking across the middle. We have delivery trucks and bin lorries around in the early mornings who may not be able to see them whilst manoeuvring especially when it's dark.
Parking Around the School	We would like to remind all parents/carers who come to school by car that it is illegal to park in the turning circle at the end of Warwick Road, even if sitting in the vehicle. By preventing other cars from turning you are creating a hazard as cars have to then reverse. Many pupils and their younger siblings are below the line of visibility for reversing drivers and the dangers are obvious. The Highway Code also prohibits stopping on the zig zag lines by school gates even if you're only dropping off or picking up. In addition please can we remind all drivers and cyclists to pay close attention to vulnerable pedestrians around the school. Many children behave in an unexpected way and it is the responsibility of drivers to pay due care and attention. Please park considerately and do not park too close to corners which reduces visibility for other road users.
Rudolf Run	On Friday 8 th December a special guest will be joining us to support the children as they run laps of the field to raise money for the Arthur Rank Hospice. The Hospice are providing a pair of antlers for every child to wear when they run and they get to keep them as a souvenir! If your child would like to come dressed in red or brown for the day to complete the Rudolph look then that would be great. Donations for this welcomed via your child's ParentPay account.



EACH will be sending home vouchers on Friday. The card allows a child to get a free book each week of the school holidays. There is a shop on Histon Road and Milton Road.
