Flu Immunisations Tuesday 19th November

The School Immunisation team will be coming into the school to deliver the vaccine on **Tuesday 19th November**. Please be aware that children can NOT receive this vaccination with their GP unless they are clinically vulnerable.

Please note that you can consent for either the **Flu nasal spray, OR the non-gelatine IM Flu vaccine**. **Please make sure you complete the form online as soon as you can, to say whether you consent or wish to decline.**
